





FACILITIES

PHYSICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

The Pre-Primary wing of the school is very vibrant, colorful and delightful through A.C. Classrooms with LCD and Play Station. A Broad-based activity programme that takes care of the psycho-dynamics of young children has been specially devised for pre-primary children. Emphasis is on conceptual learning and creative skills for strong foundation at early learning levels. The training methodologies for early learners are designed to help them grow in a natural process without the stress of work.

The School boasts of one of the best state-of-the-art auditorium. It hosts various school functions & events as well as interschool & intra school functions. It can accommodate upto a thousand spectators. The auditorium has the latest sound equipment making every programme held there a great success. It also has a projector with a computer to allow projection of presentation to the entire audience. It is indeed one of the areas of pride for the school.

SPORTS

LIBRARY

The Library at St. Lawrence is spacious, airy with a magnificent piece of architecture, making it a perfect place to study. The Library offers a range of resources to its members and these resources are provided to cater to the specific academic needs of its students. The Library has a well selected collection of several hundred Books, Journals, Periodicals, Newspapers and Audio Visual Media with wide range of subjects to choose from, which are also available for borrowing. New additions are constantly made in order to keep the library abreast of the latest.

HOSTEL

SLIS provides a natural and secure abode (hostel) to the blossoming children, providing a homely care to each individual. Presently, hostels are located in the Residential Campus of SLIS Bilaspur. The Complex has well-maintained grounds, gardens and is surrounded by concrete walls. Round-the-clock security ensures a safe haven for the students. The hostel facility at present is available for boys & girls from class 5th onwards. The students are placed in dormitories and rooms in accordance to their age. They follow



a prescribed schedule which is strictly adhered to in order to bring about discipline in their routine and create a healthy routine for a lifetime. Hostel Warden, is in the complex round-the-clock ensuring utmost attention.

TRANSPORT

To facilitate easy movement of the students to and from the School, the School provides a fleet of buses for the convenience of the students. The Transport covers most of the areas of Jagadhri, Yamuna Nagar and nearby areas like Barara, Radaur, Bilaspur, Chhachhrauli, Sadhoura, Thana Chapper, Mustfabad etc. Transport Facility is optional and the students can avail of their own means if the parents want so. Independent riding on two wheelers by a student is strictly prohibited. We are committed to provide transport facility within the range of 500 mtrs from residence of any student i.e. from the prescribed bus stop located near the residence of the students. Door to Door facility is not always committed by the school.

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

The study programme for all learning levels is unique because it is a blend of the finest teaching methodologies.

FOR PLAYGROUP / PRE-NURSERY, NURSERY & KG

PRIMARY LEVEL

Project works in class call for mass participation. An equal emphasis is laid on developing a strong sense of individuality. Use of the newspaper articles, quizzes, crosswords and other learning tools enhance general awareness.

SECONDARY LEVEL

Creativity

The emphasis is on acquiring in-depth conceptual knowledge. The curriculum is research oriented and based on teamwork vis-a-vis discussions, group project work, discovery and exploration. Personality development, value education and coping with peer pressure are stressed upon at this stage. Students work in groups and make power point presentations on subject related topics Parents are also invited for such presentations.

SENIOR SECONDARY LEVEL

The School introduced Senior Secondary Classes in Medical, Non-Medical, Commerce Faculty from Session 2017.





LABORATORIES

EMPOWERING STUDENTS

SCHOOL ASSEMBLY

The School Assembly is a gathering of the whole or part of a school in order to communicate information and share learning experiences. Our Assembly includes activities such as singing the National anthem, presenting a "thought for the day", reading of Hindi and English News headlines, giving short talks / stories on moral values, giving word of the day and Questions and Answers related to general knowledge. Each and every student is given the opportunity to address the Assembly so that they may develop public speaking skills.



THE HOUSE SYSTEM

The entire School community is divided into four Houses. It begins at Pre-primary level upto the Secondary Level and is carefully monitored at every stage and the details are recorded at every step. The houses have been named on the basis of qualities the school wants to develop in each student. The four houses are: Himalaya, Nilgiri, Shivalik and Vindhya. Each House has a House Mistress/ Master to guide the students; House Captains, Vice Captains, Prefects. Leaders are chosen from among them to foster a spirit of leadership, co-operation, mutual understanding tolerance and selfreliance. Various Inter House activities are organized to build up team spirit. The House System gives opportunities to students to face the challenges of Inter-House Competitions as well as inter School competitions.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Registration is no guarantee for Admission. Registration Fee is non-refundable.
- There is no written test for admission in Kindergarten (NURSERY & KG).
- Admission to other classes, the student has to qualify a Written Test followed by Personal Interview.

Subjects for Written Test

English, Hindi, Mathematics, Writing Skills and General Awareness.

Documents required at the time of Registration / Admission

Class NURSERY & KG

4 Passport Size Colour Photographs, Birth Certificate issued by Municipal Corporation.

Class 1st to 8th

4 Passport Size Colour Photographs, Previous Class Report Card & Transfer Certificate.

Class 9th to 11th

4 Passport Size Colour Photographs, Previous Class Report Card, Transfer Certificate, Character Certificate & CBSE Registration Card.

For further details Contact, School Office from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.

Admission Fee Relaxation Policy:

- (A) 30% Concession for Single Girl Child. (SAVE & EDUCATE EVERY GIRL CHILD)
- (B) 25% Concession for Sibling (Only Real).
- (C) 20% Concession for the wards of Professionals. (Advocate/CA/Teacher/ Doctor/Bankers/Armed Forces Personnel)
- (D) 15% Concession for the wards of Farmers having less than 2 acre Land OR Small Shopkeepers having less than Rs. 3 Lacs Annual Income.
- (E) 15% Concession for the residents of Shahkameshpur, Mehlawali, Mussimbal, Milksukhi, Mandhar & Pounti.
- (F) Merit based relaxation on the basis of Admission Tests to be conducted in Feb./March 2019.
- If a candidate is eligible for relaxation in more than one category stated above, then the higher category relaxation will only be allowed.
- In case of Sibling, Fee relaxation will not be provided to the first child.
- (Affidavit / Undertaking is a must for relaxation, duly countersigned by Sarpanch / M.C. / MLA / Notary).

5% Concession, if Lumpsum yearly payment of Tuition & Bus Fee is made.

Withdrawal/Removal from the School

- If a child has to be withdrawn from school, parents are requested to give one month's notice in writing, failing which, one month's fee will be charged in lieu thereof. Exception may be made in case of sudden transfer of Government or Armed Forces Personnel.
- 2. Those who leave school in the month of May, must have to pay the fee for the month of June.
- Transfer Certificate for children withdrawn from school are not issued until all dues are cleared.
- 4. Students can be asked to leave the school on the following grounds:
 - A. Disciplinary. B. Unsatisfactory progress. C. Detention or repetition in a class.

Mode of Fee Payment

Fee must be deposited through online transfer/Demand Draft (DD)/Cash at School Counter or Bank from 1st to 10th of the prescribed fee month, as mentioned in the Fee Structure. From 15th to 20th, a late fee fine of Rs.100/- and from 21st to 30th a late fee fine of Rs. 200/- per instalment will be charged. However, fee can be deposited in 50200029063882 in HDFC Bank for SLIS-Jagadhri and counter foil required to be deposited in school.

About the St. Lawrence

St. Lawrence is believed to have been born in Spain, at Huesca, a town in the Aragon region near the foot of the Pyrenes Mountains. As a youth he was sent to Zaragoza to complete his humanistic and theological studies. It was here he first encountered the future Pope Sixtus II, who was of Greek Origin. The future Pope was one of the most famous and esteemed teachers in, what was then one of the most renowed centres of learning. Eventually, both left Spain for Rome. When Sixtus became the Pope in 257, he ordained St. Lawrence as a deacon who served in the patriarchal church; therefore he is called" archdeacon of Rome". This was a position of great trust, which included the care of the treasury and riches of the church, and the distribution of alms among the poor.



St. Cyprian, Bishop of Carthage, notes that Roman authorities had established a norm according to which all Christians who had been denounced must be executed and their goods confiscated by imperial treasury. At the beginning of the month of August 258, the emperor Valerian issued an edict commanding that all bishops, priest and deacons should immediately be put to death. Sixtus was captured on August 6, 258 at the cemetery of St. Callixtus while celebrating the liturgy and executed forthwith.

After the death of Sixtus, the prefect of Rome demanded that St. Lawrence turn over the riches of the Church. St. Ambrose is the earliest source for the tale that Lawrence asked three days to gather the wealth. St. Lawrence worked swiftly to distribute as much Church property to the poor as possible, so as to prevent it being seized by the prefect. On the third day, at the head of a small delegation, he presented himself to the prefect, and when ordered to give up the treasures of the Church, he presented the poor, the crippled, the blind and the suffering, and said these were the true treasures of the Church. One account records him declaring to the prefect, "The Church is truly rich, far richer than your emperor". This act of defiance led directly to St. Lawrence's martyrdom and can be compared to the parallel Roman tale of the jewels of Cornelia.

On the 10th August, St. Lawrence, the last of the seven deacons, also suffered a martyr's death.
